Will sunwoda invest in a battery plant in Thailand?

Sunwoda has been approved to invest in battery cell plants in Thailand, becoming the latest Chinese battery maker to deploy battery capacity in the Southeast Asian country.

Will Thailand become a regional battery manufacturing hub?

The move strengthens Thailand's EV and energy storage supply chain as the country pushes to become a regional manufacturing hub. China's leading lithium battery producer Sunwoda has received approval from Thailand's Board of Investment (BOI) for a THB 50 billion (\$1.5 billion) investment in local battery manufacturing.

Will Thailand's first EV battery production plant boost EV industry?

Under joint efforts, venture expected to give impetus to industry in SE Asia Thailand's first domestic electric vehicle battery pack production plant went into operation on Thursday. The plant, run jointly by Chinese battery cell manufacturer Gotion High-tech and Thai company Nuovo Plus, is expected to give Southeast Asia's EV industry a boost.

Where are sunwoda batteries made?

Sunwoda's first factory in Thailand, located in Chonburi Province, will produce lithium-ion battery cells for EV makers. Several Chinese battery makers have already localized their production in Thailand, but all of them have built packs based on battery cells.
