How do I charge my phone in Zimbabwe?

Zimbabwe's electrical outlets typically accept either Type D or Type G plugs. Plug your adapter into the outlet. Connect your phone or computer charger to the adapter. Insert your charger's plug into the adapter you have connected to the outlet. Start charging. Once your charger is connected properly, your device should start charging.

Do I need a power adapter in Zimbabwe?

The standard voltage in Zimbabwe is 220-240V, and the frequency is 50Hz.
